1. Camp clothing: girls must order by next booster meeting. Girls will not get their clothing until it is paid for. Orders can be paid for when submitting order form.
 - a. Camp outfits will consist of 2 shorts (1 red and 1 black, and 3 shirts – camo shirt, thicker strapped tank, and t-shirt); there is a fourth shirt (spaghetti strapped tank) that is optional to all cheerleaders. It is not for camp; rather we just thought it was cute and wanted to offer it to the girls.
2. Pick up date for camp clothing will be announced at next booster meeting
3. Order for parents' shirts will be due by May 14th (Monday). All orders should be given to Coach Lauren with the \$. Orders will not be placed without the \$.
4. All camp \$ is due by June 5th. The total due is \$100 - \$86 for camp and \$14 for night activities (which are required).
5. Camp will be July 23-25. Night activities will be required of all girls. They are a part of camp. Rides can be provided if needed. Girls will not be out late (Pizza Party, Bowling Night, Luau)
6. Shoes will be ordered once everyone is fitted; they will possibly be in by the next booster meeting. If your daughter quits after being fitted for all this, you are still responsible for paying!
7. Weight training...varsity girls, where are you? If your daughter is not working or doing a spring sport, she should be working out with the squad. This is not mandatory, but we are keeping track of you and your attitudes!
8. Thanks to all the girls that are showing up! We are noticing your hard work and dedication.
9. Competition Tryouts: Tuesday, 5/29 at the high school auxiliary gym from 6-8. Invites only. Everyone will NOT make the team! 15-20 positions open. 4 alternates will be chosen to learn the routine.
